About the College

About AYUSH

In the former Hyderabad state, a separate Department of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy department was functioning, while in the Andhra State no separate department of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy was existing, there was only a wing in the office of the Director of Medical services under his control to look after the subject "Indigenous Medicine"

At the meeting of the interstate committee of ministers, it has been decided that the Indian Medicines & Homoeopathy should have separate Department in the Andhra Pradesh state with one special officer and two Assistant Special officers and it should not be under control of medical services. Accordingly, the Govt., in their Notification in GOMs No.59, H, dated 24/11/1956 permanently transferred the then Principal of the college of Integrated Medicines, Madras to the state of Andhra Pradesh and appointed him act as a Special officer, Indian

Medicine & Homoeopathy Department the Post of Special officer was subsequently re-designated as Director. The Director is the overall in-charge of Administration of the department.

Further, it is submitted that, the name of Indian Medicine and Homeopathy department is changed as per the Instructions of the GoI during the year 2005 as AYUSH i.e Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, siddha and Homoeopathy, as abbreviated as **AYUSH**.

Subsequently, the post of Director has been re-designated as Commissioner till the bifurcation of the state of Andhra Pradesh. After bifurcation of the state the post of Commissioner is allotted to the State of Andhra Pradesh during the year 02/6/2014. At present Dr.V.S Alagu Varsini, IAS is working as Commissioner.

Department of Botany

The Department of Botany has been one of the pioneer departments established in the year 1983, offering Botany as an optional at undergraduate level with three different combinations that include Zoology, Microbiology and Nutrition along with Botany. It also offers two skill- oriented certificate courses and a U.G.C sponsored add-on certificate course. The faculty is actively involved in research, presenting and publishing papers in international and national conferences and peer reviewed journals. The department has a well-equipped research laboratory to facilitate the faculty and students to pursue their research. The faculty with a rich experience is equipped for meeting the challenges of the present and needs of the future. Since inception the department is engaged in imparting the highest level and quality education.

The faculty is engaged in contributing towards the publication of books, research papers and is active in organizing scientific meetings, conferences and workshops

Department of Microbiology

Department of Microbiology flagged off in 1988 to share and propagate technological and biological milestones associated with tiny beasts called The Microbes. Department has three undergraduate programmes with other optional subjects as Chemistry,

Botany, Zoology & Genetics (MCB, MCZ & GCM). The motto of the department is to "Unravel the Marvels of the Miniature World"

The department envisions to lay strong foundation for life sciences in general and microbiology in practice, to facilitate scientific temper, promote analytical thinking and help transition of students learning styles from passive to active.

Department aims at conceptualizing the fundamentals of microbiology and build strong foundation, introduce the learning community the applied facets of microbiology through theory and practical skills and preparing students for fulfilling career or professional studies in Life Sciences in future.
