About Department of Journalism

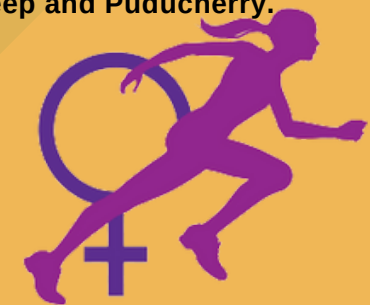
