Classical Sanskrit songs were sung by students on the occasion on of Sanskrit day celebrations on 7th Aug 2020.

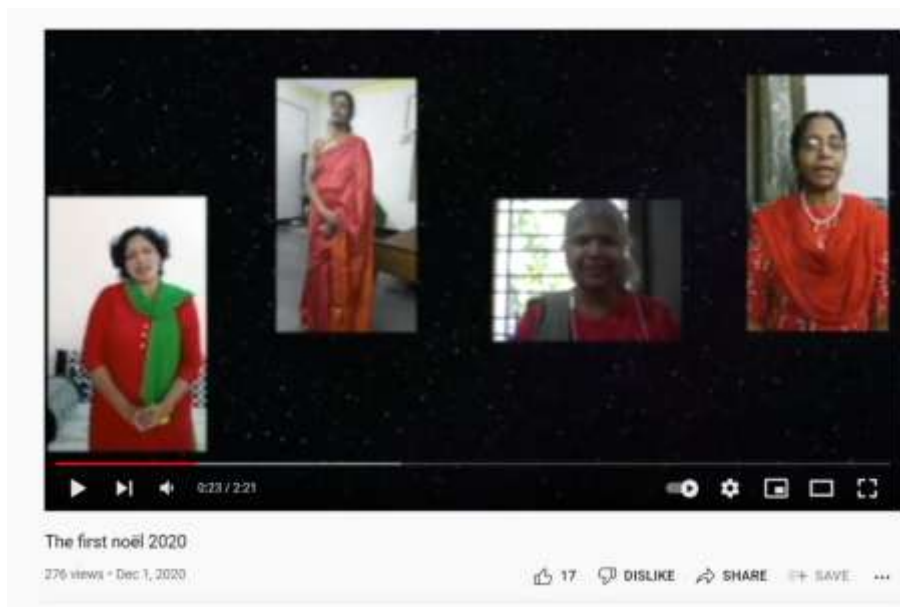

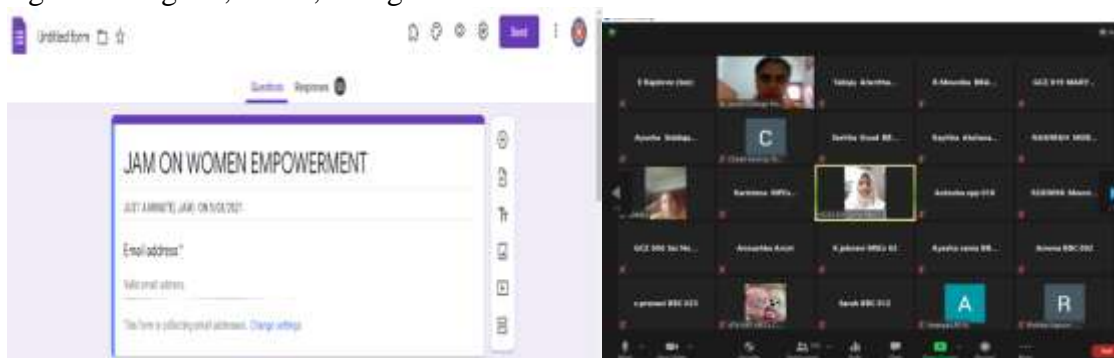




Resilient friendship bonding with Chemistry Dept

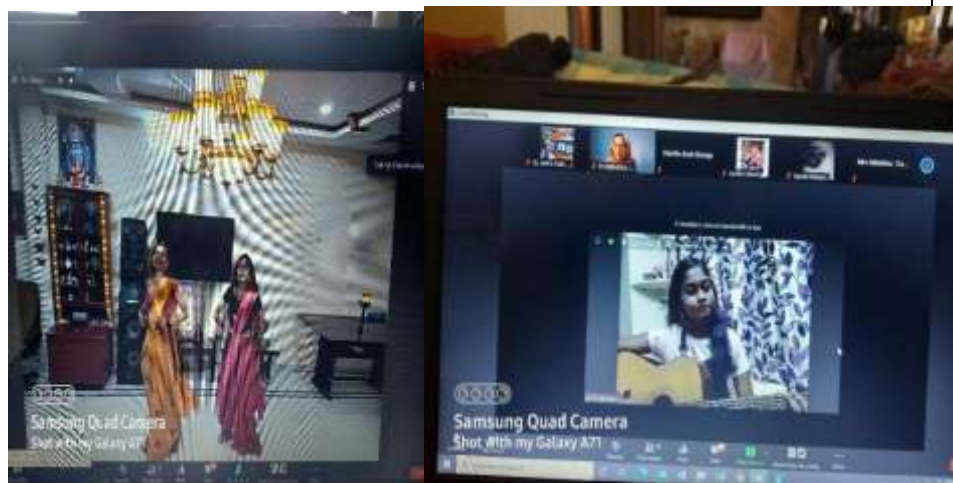
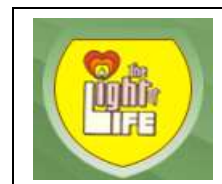

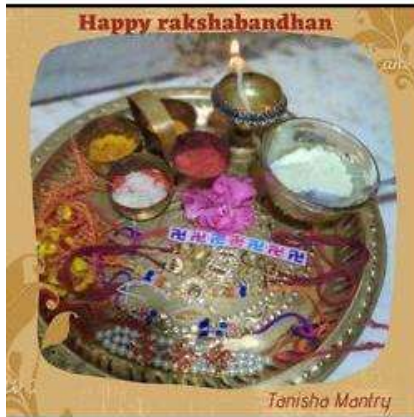
Target audience: Auxiliary staff of college

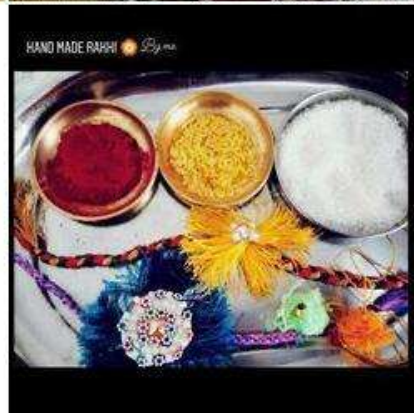

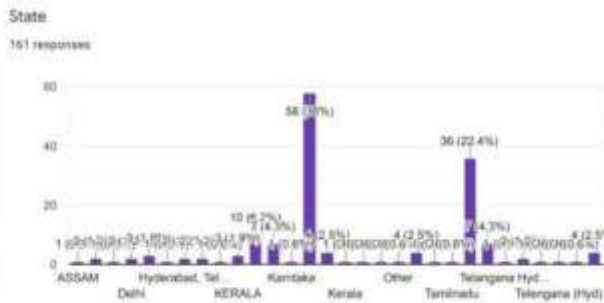
